

Did you know the HSE has reclassified welding fumes as a carcinogen?

HSE Bulletin No. STSU1 – 2019 States:

There is new scientific evidence that exposure to all welding fume, including mild steel welding fume, can cause lung cancer. There is also limited evidence linked to kidney cancer.

There is a change in HSE enforcement expectations in relation to the control of exposure of welding fume.

All businesses undertaking welding activities should ensure effective engineering controls are provided and used to control fume arising from those welding activities.

ACTION REQUIRED

HSE's bulletin suggests that Local Exhaust Ventilation (LEV) solutions are a typical means of helping to control exposure to welding fumes.
