In addition to this we represent a large range of manufacturers of air compressors, lubrication equipment and general workshop equipment.


Workshop Planning

MOT Bay design & Installation

Many people these days want to upgrade their conventional bay to a One Person Test Lane (OPTL) or full Automated Test Lane (ATL).

MOT Calibrations



We know how important the upkeep of a busy MOT bay or truck test lane is. It is for this reason that we treat the provision of calibration contracts for test bays with such priority.

When you choose one of our calibration contracts we create a unique database record on our computerised management system and then we keep track of when your next visit is due.

We contact you near to the due date and mutually agree a calibration appointment. Ensuring that we are accredited with CSA means that we can calibrate and repair certain emissions equipment, along with most popular brake testers and headlamp testers. We can also organise tooling calibrations to help you comply with ISO or dealer standards.



Planned Maintenance

We specialise in providing maintenance services to suit a wide range of equipment.

Reliance on workshop equipment to generate revenue, and increased health & safety legislation mean that more and more managers are realising the benefits of planned preventative maintenance packages.

Our service plans are designed to suit new and old equipment alike. Many people who have their equipment maintained often have up to six different companies servicing their equipment at a high cost and inconvenience.

At Gott Technical Services we train our engineers to carry out a prescribed list of extensive checks on equipment.

We believe in being thorough with this for health and safety reasons and to ensure, as far as possible, that future breakdowns on your equipment are kept to a minimum, thereby providing peace of mind.



When we service or calibrate your equipment we attach a label which clearly identifies the last date it was inspected, and when the next visit is due. For each vehicle lift serviced our engineers complete a 32 point inspection sheet and inspection report which meets the requirements of the LOLER regulations. If you have a service plan with us we will provide you with a branded document storage folder to keep all job sheets, reports and certificates in.

As with our MOT calibrations, we closely monitor when Planned Maintenance visits are due using our computerised helpdesk and contracts management system.

This system also includes a comprehensive equipment register which records all maintenance, calibration, warranty and breakdown history against each piece of equipment.

Statutory inspections

"Are thorough examinations or inspections the same as routine maintenance?"

Some people believe because they have statutory inspections carried out on their equipment they do not require maintenance. This is not correct. The following text is an excerpt from HSE guide INDG4222 which clearly states that routine maintenance is essential for continued safe use of equipment.

"No. Routine maintenance typically involves checking and replacing worn or damaged parts, lubrication, replacing time-expired components, topping up fluid levels, and making routine adjustments. This is to ensure the equipment continues to operate as intended, and risks associated with wear or deterioration are avoided.

Thorough examination may indicate areas of poor maintenance, but is not intended to replace it. You should not wait for the results of a thorough examination before carrying out maintenance on your lifting equipment. Maintenance is a requirement under PUWER and applies to all work equipment including lifting equipment."




Pressure Systems Safety Regulations 2000

We can provide drawings and Written Schemes of Examination to enable you to comply with the Pressure Systems Safety Regulations 2000.

These regulations apply to anybody that operates a pressure system including compressed air stored in an air receiver

or ringmain. The schemes are written up, and inspections completed, by an independent, competent person.

Legally a pressure system must have a written scheme before it can be operated.





LEV Inspection & Certification

As well as installing new fume and dust extraction systems we carry out LEV tests to help you comply with your COSHH obligations. We can also carry out any necessary repairs to your systems as required.

Our work incorporates P602 extraction design and installation and P601 LEV COSHH inspections.
